The Garden Center

The Tallahassee Garden Center built in 1848 for Henry Rutgers (city Councilman and territorial treasurer 1842-1844) by George Proctor, a free black who built many of the early Tallahassee homes, is one of Tallahassee's historic landmarks. The doors and woodwork are mahogany, most of the lumber hand-hewn from native trees, and the bricks came from a local kiln north of the Grove. The original grounds included a smoke-house, an outdoor kitchen and a large carriage house.

This historical home, occupying half a city block in downtown Tallahassee, was purchased by the Tallahassee Garden Club in 1954. A remodeling program begun in 1969 has enlarged the original auditorium to accommodate 100 people. At the same time, central heat and air conditioning was installed. Thanks to generous contributions from members and friends of TGC, more recent improvements include the completion of the spacious and lovely Arvah Hopkins patio, new electrical wiring, interior and exterior painting and redecorating, and the addition of a garden gazebo which all add to the charm of the Garden center.

The Tallahassee Garden Center has become an important civic asset, providing a central place for club and community activities, adding beauty to our city and preserving a place of historic interest. The Board of Trustees welcomes rental of our lovely facility for private functions. For more information on available dates and times, contact our Resident manager.
